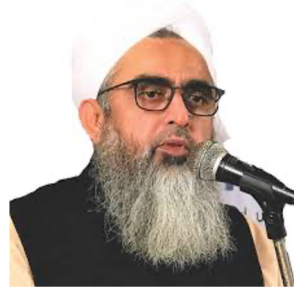

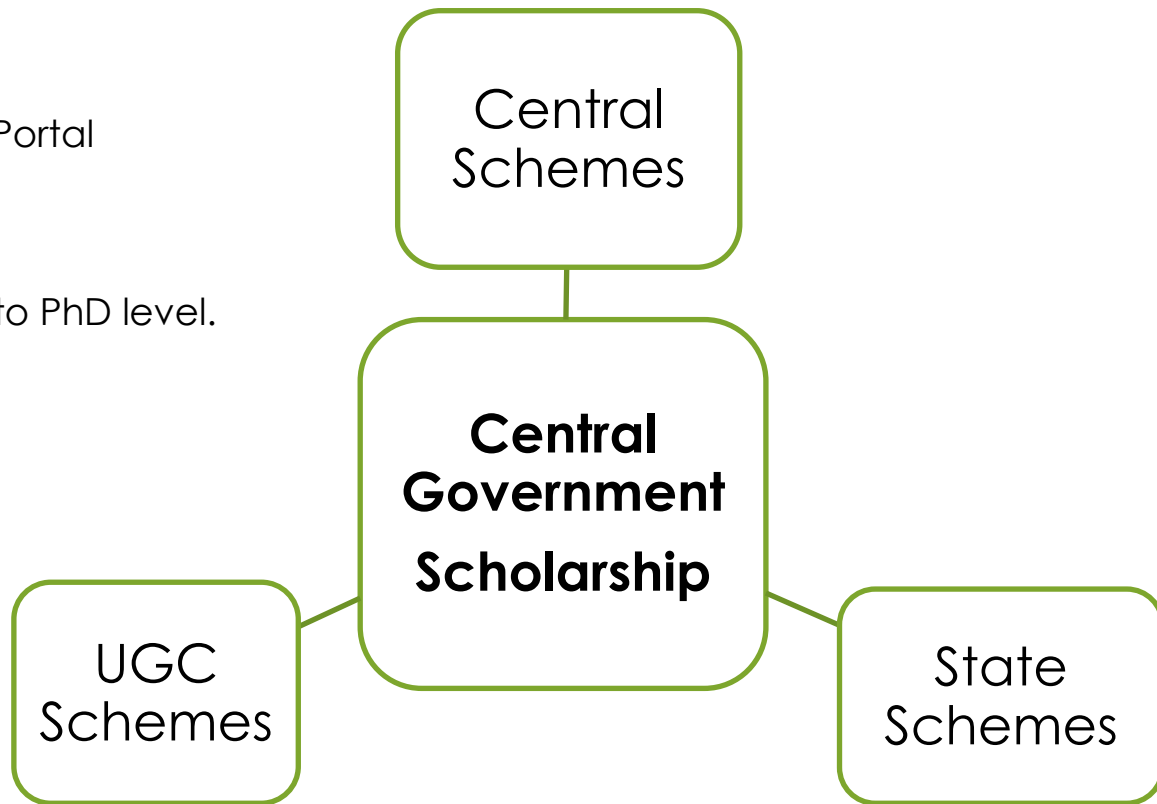

Prime Minister's Scholarship Scheme For RPF/RPSF

WHO CAN APPLY:

- Students pursuing higher technical and professional education who are dependent wards of Ex/Serving RPF/RPSF personnel and widows.
- Professional Degree Courses like BE, B.Tech, BDS, MBBS, BEd, BBS, BCA, MCA B. Pharma, etc. duly recognized by the respective Government Regulatory Bodies, such as All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), Medical Council of India (MCI), University Grants Commission (UGC), National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) etc.
- (Master Degree Courses are not eligible for PMSS except MBA, MCA).

ELIGIBILITY:

- Minimum 60% in last exam

WHO CAN APPLY:

- The First and Second Rank holders at undergraduate level and admitted in any Postgraduate Course

ELIGIBILITY:

- Age limit for the students is 30 years

Rs. 37,200/- Approx.

RATE OF SCHOLARSHIP:

- Amount of fellowship: Rs.3,100/- p.m for a period of two years only i.e. full duration of a PG course.
- No other additional grant will be payable in lieu of hostel charges and medical charges etc.



PG SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR SC ST STUDENTS FOR PERSUING PROFESSIONAL COURSES

WHO CAN APPLY:

- The objective of the scheme is to provide financial assistance to 1000 SC/ST candidates to pursue postgraduate level studies in Professional subjects in the eligible institutions.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Only professional course students.

Rs. 54,000/- to 93,000/- Approx.

RATE OF SCHOLARSHIP:

- Candidates selected for the award of PG scholarships (under ME/MTech.) shall be provided Scholarship @ Rs.7800/-per month for the duration of the PG Scholarship.
- For other courses, the amount of scholarship will be paid @Rs.4500/- per month.

FAQs for National Scholarship Portal (NSP)

Q-1) Who are eligible to apply for Scholarship Schemes?

Students fulfilling the scheme guidelines of various Ministries are eligible to apply for these scholarships. These are available on the Home page of the portal.

Q-2) What is the last date for submitting applications online?

Closure dates for acceptance of various scholarship applications are available in National Scholarships portal.

Q-3) How can I apply online for scholarship?

In order to apply online, please visit the website through URL www.scholarships.gov.in

Q-4) How to submit the online application? Should I need the user id and password to apply for scholarship?

Applying procedures for scholarship schemes for both Fresh and Renewal are given below:

Fresh: Student have to click on the option, Student Login, on the home page of National scholarships Portal. Fill up the application as per the instructions given by the system then click on save button. After saving, student will get a "Temporary ID". The system will instruct the applicant to submit his/her Temporary ID and date of birth to fill subsequent details. Once registration is complete on click of submit button, a permanent Registration ID is generated which can be used for Renewal and tracking the status of application

Renewal: Renewal students have to apply with their Application id and Date of Birth which they registered previous year. Student can also use Forgot Application ID to retrieve their ID only those students would be able to renew who had actually got the scholarships payments last year from NSP 1.0.



FAQs for National Scholarship Portal (NSP)

Q-5) Can I edit the information already saved and up-to what time?

All the information can be edited till the closure of application form. After final submission, your application will be forwarded to the next level and application hereby cannot be edited.

Q-6) Which fields in the application form are mandatory?

Fields provided with red asterisk (*) mark are mandatory fields.

Q-7) What happens, if I detect mistakes after forwarding the applications to the next level?

You should separately inform the mistakes detected by you to the institute/District/Region/State. The software provides facility at the level of the institute & state to edit & correct limited information.

Q-8) Which fields institute /State can edit ?

The Fields which can be edited are Gender, Religion, Category, profession, Annual Income, Aadhar Number, Disability, Day Scholar/Hostile Mode of Study, IFSCE Code, Account No., Admission Fees and tuition Fees. However, corrections made by the institute/state, if any, would be conveyed instantly to the student through SMS/email.

Q-9) Do I have to fill up the online application in one sitting ?

No. You can fill up the online application in as many sittings as you wish, until you are satisfied that you have entered a desirable fields correctly. The software provides facility to save your application at every stage.

Q-10) What is UID number/Aadhaar Number?

UID number otherwise known as Aadhaar, number is Unique identification Number given by Unique identification Authority of India (UIDAI). Aadhaar is unique 12 digit number assigned after de-duplication of biometrics.

Q-11) Do I need to get my Aadhaar Card to apply for Scholarship ?

Aadhaar No. is not Mandatory for the Students in order to Register and fill up the application form online. Students can apply for scholarship without entering the Aadhaar no. but in that case they have to enter Aadhaar Enrolment id. For the states of Aasam, Meghalya and Mizoram Aadhar Number is not mandatory.

Q-12) Is there any permanent ID? How will it be communicated to me ?

Yes. An Application ID (permanent ID) will, be provided to the candidate once his/her Registration is done. It will, be conveyed to candidates through SMS and e-mail. students should memorize their Application ID as it will, be required while applying for Fresh/renewal scholarship.

Q-13) Can I apply as a Fresh if I am a Renewal candidate ?

No, you cannot apply as a fresh if you are a Renewal candidate. your application will be rejected in that case.

Q-14) What should I do, if I do not find my institute name in the drop-down menu ?

You should immediately approach the institute to contact with the nodal officer of the state where the institute is located. you can also approach the Nodal officer of that state directly through e-mail under intimation to the Ministry. If your institute is an eligible institution, the State Government concerned would enter it into the database and then you can apply.

Q-15) How do I know the name and address of Nodal officer/ state Department of my State ?

The name and contact details of the Nodal Officer/State Department of all States/UTs are available in "services->Know your State Nodal Officer,, option.

Q-16) How to check the status of my application ?

Student can check the status of Online Application by submitting his/her Permanent id and Date of Birth and open the link "Check your Status.

Q-17) How to view the details of a particular scheme ?

You may click on Guidelines link of particular Scheme displaying in On-Boarded schemes section on the Home page.

The deadline for verification of application at Institute /District/State Level will be displayed on portal as and when the dates are being closed.

Q-24) How to handle the issue of length of Bank Account Number being restricted to 15 characters in NSP2.0 where the bank provides 16 or 18 characters ?

The length of the Account Number has been increased sufficiently.

Q-25) In case applicant is unable to select Block/Taluk, how to overcome this issue ?

The Block/Taluka has made Optional.

Q-26) Telephone helpline Number 0120-5619540 given on NSP2.0 portal is not functioning properly and lot of calls are being put on hold ?

The Telephone Helpline is been strengthened. More nodes are been added and working hours are also being increased.

Q-27) Would the Login credentials be sent by SMS?

Yes. The Application Id and Password sent by SMS.

Q-28) How to know the contact details of various Nodal Officers?

Q-29) What is the remedy in case some scholarship scheme is not coming in drop down list ?

As per the inputs provided by the student, if these do not fit into the Guidelines, . then Scholarship cannot be provided.

Students belonging to six notified minority communities viz. Muslim, Christian, Sikh, Buddhist, Jain, Parsi (Zoroastrian) studying in India only and fulfilling the Scheme guidelines are eligible to apply for these scholarships.

Q-2) How can I apply online for scholarship?

The Pre-Metric, Post Metric and Merit cum Means based Scholarship Schemes are online Schemes and one can apply for fresh or renewal Scholarship under any of these Schemes on the National Scholarship Portal (NSP) at www.scholarships.gov.in. Link to the Portal is also provided on the website of the Ministry of Minority Affairs, i.e. www.minorityaffairs.gov.in. An online undertaking has to be submitted for registration on the NSP by applicants who are above the age of 18 years and by the parents/guardian if the applicant is below the age of 18 years.

Q-3) What documents are needed to be uploaded on Portal while applying for Scholarship?

The following documents are required to be uploaded for Fresh applications under the Merit cum Means based Scholarship if the amount of Scholarship is more than Rs. 50,000/- per annum. Uploading of document is not necessary for applying under Pre-Matric and Post-Matric Scholarship Scheme.

1. Student Photo.
2. Verification Form to be provided by the Institution.
3. Income Certificate issued by the Competent Authority in the State/UT Government.
4. A self certified Community Certificate from the applicant who has attained 18 years of age and for others the Community Certificate certified by parent/guardian is required.
5. Applicants for Scholarship under MCM based Scheme have to upload self-attested Mark Sheet, indicating that the applicant has secured not less than 50% marks in the last qualifying exam at higher secondary/ graduation level.

6. Fee Receipt of 'Current Course Year'.
7. Bank Account number of the Student along with the IFSC Code of the bank branch (for Pre Matric Scheme where students do not have their own bank account, parents/guardian can provide their own account details).
8. Residential/Domicile Certificate.
9. Aadhaar number of the student and if Aadhaar is not available then bonafide student certificate from the school/institute and scanned copies of bank passbook and Aadhaar enrolment ID (if applied for Aadhaar).
10. If School/Institute is located in a State/UT different from domicile State/UT of the applicant then bonafide student certificate from School/Institute. In case of Renewal of Scholarship for the next academic year the applicant has to provide a certificate that she/he has secured 50% marks in the previous year's examination, pursued from the same school/institute. In the case of renewal under the MCM based Scheme the applicant must have pursued the same course from the same institute in the previous year and secured 50% marks in each semester/trimester as the case may be.

Q-4) What should be the Type and size of the documents to be uploaded?

The format of the file should be.pdf and .jpeg and the size of each document should not exceed more than 200 kb.

- i. Student Photo.
- ii. Income Certificate of Parent/Guardian issued by the Competent Authority in the State/UT.
- iii. A self certified Community Certificate from the applicant who has attained 18 years of age and for others the Community Certificate certified by parent/ guardian is required.
- iv. Applicants for Scholarship under MCM based Scheme have to upload self-attested Mark Sheet, indicating that the applicant has secured not less than 50% marks in the last qualifying exam at higher secondary/ graduation level.
- v. Bank Account number of the Student along with the IFSC Code of the bank branch (for Pre Matric Scheme where students do not have their own bank account, parents can provide their own account details).
- vi. Aadhaar number of the student and if Aadhaar is not available then copies of bank passbook and Aadhaar enrolment ID (if applied for Aadhaar).

Q-6) What is Institute Verification Certificate?

In order to enable a student to apply for Scholarship under any of the 3 Schemes' the Institute/School will have to appoint Nodal Officer and that Nodal Officer should register herself/himself on the portal (NSP). A format of the 'Institute Nodal Officer Registration Form' is given at Annexure-I.

Q-7) What instructions should be followed by student while filling up Bank Account details?

- (i) Students/Parents/Guardians must enter IFSC code of their bank branch carefully. (ii) Thereafter the complete Saving Bank Account number must be entered correctly. Students/Parents/Guardians are advised to get account number verified by the concerned Bank Branch as the Scholarship amount will not be transferred if the bank details are incorrect.
- (iii) Bank Account holder must check their 'Know your Customer' (KYC) status from bank and if required the KYC must be done for successful transaction of scholarship amount.
- (iv) Applicants are advised to link their bank account with Aadhaar, for faster disbursement and ensure that the account remains active till the disbursement of the Scholarship.
- (v) Bank account must be operational/active till disbursement of Scholarship (for all eligible applicants) so that payment does not fail.
- (vi) Bank account must be preferably in a Scheduled Bank (as per Reserve Bank of India) with core banking facility.
- (vii) In case of Post-Matric and Merit-cum-Means based Scholarship Schemes, the bank account must be in name of the applicant/student only. In case of Pre- Matric Scholarship Scheme, the bank account should be in the name of either applicant/student or the applicant can have a joint account with his/her mother/father/guardian as indicated in the application.

Q-8) What is UID number/Aadhaar Number?

UID number otherwise known as 'Aadhaar' number is Unique Identification Number given by Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI). The Aadhaar Number is required to be seeded (linked) with the bank account in which Scholarship amount is desired to be transferred. Banks provide multiple ways of linking Aadhaar with the bank account and applicants can obtain the details from the website of the concerned bank or contact the concerned bank with a copy of the Aadhaar card.

Q-9) Do I need to get my Aadhaar Card to apply for Scholarship?

As per the Gazette Notification issued by Ministry of Minority Affairs under Section-7 of Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 (18 of 2016) with respect to the Scholarship Schemes, it will be necessary for the eligible applicants to provide Aadhaar number while applying for the Scholarship and in case, and the applicant does not possess Aadhaar she/he can provide the details of alternative identification documents, as stated in the Gazette Notification, detailed below:

- (a) (i) if she or he has enrolled, her or his Aadhaar Enrolment ID (EID) slip; or
- (ii) a copy of her or his request made for Aadhaar enrolment, as specified in sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph 2; and
- (b) (i) Bank passbook with photograph; or
- (ii) Ration Card, or
- (iii) Permanent Account Number (PAN) Card issued by the Income Tax Department; or
- (iv) Passport; or
- (v) Certificate of identity having photo of such student issued by a Headmaster or Principal of School under official seal of the school; or
- (vi) Driving license issued by the Licensing Authority under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988); or (
- (vii) any other documents specified by the State Government or Union territory Administration.

If EID number is entered, the applicant will be advised to update the Aadhaar number on NSP through applicants' login, as soon as the Aadhaar number is assigned. Aadhaar number can be updated upto one month from the last date of application. In case the applicant fails to update Aadhaar number by that date the application will be treated as non-Aadhaar application and dealt with accordingly. [Note- For Assam, Jammu & Kashmir and Meghalaya, the documents mentioned at para (b) shall only be required]

Q-10) What is Aadhaar based Payment?

Applicants/Students who have entered Aadhaar in their online application correctly and if their Aadhaar is linked to any of their bank account, in such cases the amount of Scholarship will be credited to that Aadhaar linked bank account only even if the student has mentioned any other non-Aadhaar linked bank account in her/his online application.

Q-11) Can I edit the information already saved and up to what time?

You can edit draft/incomplete information filled by you until you 'Submit' the online application. To edit the application, go to the option "Student login" → enter the Application Id then click on submit 'login' button.

Q-12) Which fields I can edit before final submission of application?

You can edit all details except "Registration Details". It may be noted that once you 'finally submit' your application it will be forwarded to the next level and after that you cannot edit further.

Q-13) Which fields in the application form are mandatory?

Fields provided with red asterisk(*) mark are mandatory fields.

Q-14) Do I have to fill up the online application in one sitting?

No. You can fill up the online application in many sittings using 'Save Draft', until you are satisfied that you have entered all desirable fields correctly. The software provides facility to save your application at every stage until you click on 'Submit' button.

Q-15) Is there any Application ID?

Yes. An Application ID will be provided to the candidate once his/her application is submitted online. It will be conveyed to candidates through SMS. Students should remember their ID as it will be required while applying for renewal during subsequent years. Receipt of ID does not give itself a guarantee award of scholarship.

Q-16) What should I do if I forget my Application ID?

The process of re-collection of the Application ID is given as below:

“Student login-•>Forgot Registration Details?” then enter the basic fields accordingly and click on the button “Get Registration details””.

Q-17) What should I do, if my Institute name is not coming in the drop- down list of Institutes in application form?

You may ask your institute to contact the concerned State Department for their registration through U-DISE/AISHE/NCVT(DGT) code available on NSP portal. If still the institute is unable to get registered on NSP portal, they may contact to NUEPA (National University of Educational Planning and Administration) and Department of School Education of their State (for U-DISE) code /AICTE (for AISHE code) / NCVT (for ITI courses) and confirm that their UDISE/AISHE/NCVT code has been approved by the School Education Department/AICTE/NCVT and updated in the data base of NUEPA/AICTE/NCVT(DGT), only then Institute will be able to register on NSP portal.

Q-18) What should I do, if I do not find my Course name in the drop- down menu?

You should immediately approach the institute (where you are studying) to login their account and add the concerned Course from the Master course list. Thereafter, you may be able to find the desired course name in your online application. If the desired course is not available even in the Master course list of Institute login, you/your Institute should immediately approach to the concerned State Department (where your Institute is physically located) to add the course. Name of course and course duration along with the supporting documents must be provided to the State department.

Q-19) How should I check the status of my application online?

You have to login under the option 'Student Login' by entering your Application Id and Password. Once login, you will be able to view the option 'Check Your Status'. Under this option you can check your online status.

Q-20) What should I do before making any call/enquiry/representation at helpdesk of National Informatics Centre (NIC) and/or Ministry of Minority Affairs (MoMA)?

The applicant should first check his/her online status on NSP as stated in Q. No. 17 and then make any call/enquiry/representation at helpdesk of National Informatics Centre (NIC) and/or Ministry of Minority Affairs (MoMA).

Q-21) What is the process of verification of my application?

Your application must be verified at School/Institute level and then at domicile district/ domicile State/UT level. You may contact the concerned verification authorities for online verification of your application within the timeline given on the NSP portal. Ministry of Minority Affairs will release the scholarship amount, only if your application is verified and approved by all verification authorities. In case, your application is rejected by any of the concerned authority due to any reason, you will not get the scholarship amount.

Q-22) How can I check whether the amount of my scholarship is credited in my bank account or not?

You may check the transaction status on PFMS portal i.e. www.pfms.nic.in under "Know Your Payment" (<https://pfms.nic.in/static/NewLayoutCommonContent.aspx?RequestPageName=static/KnowYourPayment.aspx>) option on the home page.

Q-23) What should I do for the successful payment of Scholarship in my bank account?

You are advised to keep your bank account active to receive the scholarship amount (till the disbursement of scholarships). Confirm from your bank that your account is not dormant/closed and also be sure that your account is free from transaction limit or any other conditions till the disbursement of scholarship is made in your account, to avoid any chance of transaction failure/return of scholarship amount. Please note that in case of transaction failure/return of scholarship amount, there is no provision for re-payment and Ministry of Minority Affairs is not responsible for such lapse.

Q-24) How do I know the name and address of Nodal Officer/ State Department of my State?

The name and contact details of the Nodal Officer/State Department of all States/UTs are available under the link of Ministry of Minority Affairs on the home page of National Scholarship Portal (NSP)

Q-25) Which fields are editable for verification authorities i.e. for Institute/District/State while verification of online application?

At Institute level, only 'Fee' can be edited by the concerned Institute. However, at District/State level verifying authorities, 'Aadhaar Number' & 'Mobile Number' of the student can be edited.

Q-26) What should I do if I come to know after final submission, that my application is 'defected' by the Institute/District/State verifying authority?

In case the application is marked as 'defected' by the Institute/District/State, the application will be reverted to the student for correction of the defect in his/her application form. Student can correct the defect and resubmit the application for re-verification within the timeline given on NSP.

Q-27) What should I do if I come to know after final submission, that my application is 'rejected' by the Institute/District/State verifying authority?

In case the application is marked as 'rejected' by the Institute/District/State, the application will not be considered for award of the scholarship.

Q-28) What should I do if I face some technical issue while applying for scholarship on NSP portal.

You can immediately register your complain through the link <https://scholarships.gov.in/fresh/complaintspage> or accessing Complaints -> Register Complaints on the home page of the NSP website or call on the Helpline number 0120-6619540 or send mail on e-mail id: helpdesk@nsp.gov.in.

Q-29) What percentage of disability is considered for scholarship?

Disability with 40% and above and having a valid certificate of disability as prescribed under rules issued by the competent authority is considered for scholarship.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS FOR ISHAN UDAY

Q-1) Is the scheme open for all candidates enrolled in Indian Universities/ Colleges/ Institutes?

No. Only those candidates who have domicile of the North-Eastern states of India are covered under the schemes i.e. Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland and Tripura.

Q-2) Is there any annual income ceiling for candidates to be included under the scheme.

Yes, only those candidates whose annual family income is not equal or more than Rs.4.5 lakh per annum are covered under ambit of the scheme.

Q-3) Is there any need for uploading of domicile certificate along with the online application form.

Yes, the domicile certificate/ permanent resident certificate issued by the competent authority will have to be uploaded with the online application form.

Q-4) Are only first year undergraduate students eligible to apply?

Yes, only those students who have passed Class XII(CBSE board) or equivalent Examination of State Boards of NER are eligible to apply?

Q-5) Are students enrolled in Diploma courses or those who have cleared Class XII exam or equivalent in the preceding years eligible to apply?

No. Only those students who have qualified class XII exam or equivalent exam during the current academic year are eligible to apply.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS FOR ISHAN UDAY

Q-6) Are students enrolled in private/deemed universities (not funded by either Central or State Government) eligible to apply?

No. The scheme is applicable for students of first year undergraduate courses and enrolled in the following institutions are eligible to apply :-

Q-7) Are students enrolled in integrated courses of eligible institutions eligible to apply?

Yes. Students enrolled in integrated courses are eligible to apply. The awardees will however draw scholarship only for the undergraduate part of the course.

Q-8) Are students enrolled in dual degree courses eligible to apply?

Yes. However, the awardees will be eligible to draw scholarship only till the tenure of the first degree programme.

Q-9) Are all courses covered under the ambit of the scheme?

Yes. The scholarship will be awarded in general degree courses, professional courses, technical courses, medical and paramedical courses (including MBBS, BAMS, BDS, B.Arch, BTech etc.)

Q-10) IS there a difference in amount of scholarship payable to the awardees? How will payments be regulated?

Yes. There are two amounts of scholarship payable to the awardees? Rs.5400/- p.m. for general degree courses viz. BA, BSc., BCom., BMS, BBA etc. and Rs.7800/- p.m. for other courses viz. technical, professional, medical, paramedical courses etc. The amount of scholarship payable will be determined according to the verification provided by the institution at the time of applying.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS FOR ISHAN UDAY

Q-11) Will the scholarship transferred in case the awardee changes the institution or course during the tenure of scholarship?

There is no provision for transfer of scholarship.

Q-12) Will the scholarship be renewed if the awardee fails in the first or subsequent years of study?

No. The scholarship will not be renewed if the awardee fails to qualify in the annual or term end examinations of the course.

Q-13) Will the students who have enrolled in some course in distance mode or have obtained admission through management quota be considered eligible for award of scholarship.

No these categories of students will not be considered for award of scholarship.

Q-14) Can the awardees claim any other scholarship (State/ Institute or other Ministry) during the tenure of award of this scholarship?

No. Such students will not be considered for award of this scholarship.

Q-15) Can the students apply anytime during the year of admission?

No. Students can only apply online on the NPS(<https://nationalscholarshipportal>) during a particular time period as displayed on the website.



FAQ'S FOR PG INDIRA GANDHI SCHOLARSHIP FOR SINGLE GIRL CHILD

Q-1) Whether the candidate has to select “scholarship” or “incentive” in the type of scholarship for applying under the scheme?

The candidate has to opt for “incentive” to be able to apply under the scheme.

Q-2) Whether a girl child with a brother in the family is eligible to be considered under the scheme for award of scholarship.

No, only single girl child are eligible to apply under the scheme. However twin/ fraternal daughters are eligible to apply under this scheme.

Q-3) Whether a candidate who was within 30 years of age during admission to PG course but has crossed this limit at the time of application be eligible to be considered.

Yes. The candidate applying under the scheme can apply if she is below 30 years of age as on the last date of application too.

Q-4) Can a single girl child pursuing post graduation through distance mode apply under the scheme?

No.

Q-5) After selection, is the awardee entitled for hostel fee reimbursement/ HRA or medical expenses?

No. The awardee is only entitled for scholarship amount. No HRA/contingency/hostel fee or medical expenses are admissible.



FAQ'S FOR PG INDIRA GANDHI SCHOLARSHIP FOR SINGLE GIRL CHILD

Q-6) Are the awardees eligible for waiver of tuition fee or its reimbursement?

No. Tuition fee reimbursement is not permitted. However, it is expected from the institutions where student has taken admission in the first year PG course, no tuition fees will be charged by the institute from girl students to pursue PG degree course in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.

Q-7) Can students of second year post graduation apply under the scheme?

No. The candidates who are pursuing first year postgraduate courses only can apply under the scheme.

Q-8) Can the awardee avail of any other scholarship scheme during the tenure of this award?

Yes. This scheme can be availed with any other scholarship scheme as this is an incentive.



FAQs PG SCHOLARSHIP FOR UNIVERSITY RANK HOLDERS (1st and 2nd RANK HOLDERS)

Q-1) Whether the candidate has to select “scholarship” or “incentive” in the type of scholarship for applying under the scheme?

The candidate has to opt for “incentive” to be able to apply under the scheme

Q-2) Are all first and second rank holders at undergraduate level eligible for applying under the scheme?

The First and Second Rank holders at undergraduate level and who are admitted in any Postgraduate Course would be awarded the scholarship in application . The students will have to submit the proof of their merit position at undergraduate level as well as their admission in postgraduate courses.

Q-3) Is there a minimum percentage of marks for applying under the scheme?

Yes. The candidates applying under the scheme should have secured at least 60% of marks at undergraduate level to be eligible to apply under the scheme.

Q-4) Are only students enrolled in Universities eligible to apply under the scheme?

The first and second rank holders (Not position holders) would be considered from Universities/ Institutions and non-affiliated/ autonomous colleges according to the number of students who have appeared in the examination at undergraduate level as per following table.

Nature of Institution	Number of students who appeared in examination at undergraduate level
Affiliating Universities (State/ Central)	100
Deemed Universities/ Private Universities / Autonomous Colleges / Non-affiliated colleges	25



FAQs PG SCHOLARSHIP FOR UNIVERSITY RANK HOLDERS (1st and 2nd RANK HOLDERS)

Q-5) Are candidates holding positions in Universities at undergraduate level eligible to apply under the scheme?

No. Only those candidates who are first or second rank holders in the university are eligible to apply.

Q-6) Can a candidate pursuing post graduation through distance mode apply under the scheme?

No.

Q-7) Are awardees entitled for hostel fee reimbursement, contingency, HRA or medical expenses?

No. Contingency, HRA, hostel fee reimbursement or medical expenses are not admissible under the scheme.



FAQs FOR PG SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR SC ST STUDENTS FOR PERSUING PROFESSIONAL COURSES

Q-1) How many students can benefit from this scholarship?

It provide financial assistance to 1000 SC/ST candidates to pursue postgraduate level studies in Professional subjects in the eligible institutions.

Q-2) What is the eligibility criteria?

For the purpose of award of the scholarship students who are pursuing professional courses in the following Institutions/ Colleges/Universities: Universities/Institutions/Colleges included under section 2(f) & and 12(B) of UGC Act. Deemed to be Universities included under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956 and eligible to receive grants-in-aid from UGC, Universities/Institutions/College funded by Central/State Government. Institutes of National Importance. Courses which require approval from Regulatory Council i.e. Medical Council of India (MCI), Dental Council of India (DCI), Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI), NCTIS, NCTE Bar council of India (BCI), All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), INC, FORENSIC REGULATORY & DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OF INDIA are considered professional courses.

Note 1: M.A., M.Sc., M.Com., MSW and Mass Communication and Journalism degree are accepted as “Non-professional courses”:

Note 2: Candidates pursuing post graduate course in professional subjects through correspondence or in Distance Education mode are not eligible to receive financial assistance under this scheme.

Q-3) Are all candidates pursuing post graduate courses in Indian Universities/ Colleges/ Institutes eligible for this award?

No. This scheme is meant only for SC/ST students. General category/ OBC candidates are not eligible to apply under the scheme.



FAQs FOR PG SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR SC ST STUDENTS FOR PERSUING PROFESSIONAL COURSES

Q-4) Are students belonging to SC/ST category who are pursuing post graduation through correspondence/ distance mode eligible for the award?

No. Candidates pursuing post graduate course in professional subjects through correspondence or in Distance Education mode are not eligible to receive financial assistance under this scheme.

Q-5) Are awardees selected under this scheme eligible to draw contingency and HRA?

No. The awardees are only eligible to receive scholarship amount.

Q-6) Are students of eligible category who are pursuing post graduation and are in the second year of study eligible to apply under the scheme?

No. Only students pursuing first year of postgraduate course during the current academic year are eligible to apply.



FAQS ABOUT MAHADBT SCHOLARSHIP PORTAL

Q-1) What is Aaple Sarkar DBT?

Aaple Sarkar DBT (Direct Benefit Transfer) is a portal launched by Government of Maharashtra to transfer the benefits and subsidies of various social welfare schemes like E-Scholarships, Pension, Disaster, etc., directly into the bank account of the beneficiary.

Q-2) Who can apply into the Aaple Sarkar DBT Portal

Any Citizen of India can register on the portal. Eligibility and disbursement will be according to the schemes as displayed.

Q-3) How long is the OTP valid?

OTP is valid for 30 mins

Q-4) How does Aadhaar based DBT help me as a beneficiary?

Aadhaar seeding your scheme ensures that nobody else can claim your share of the benefits by impersonating you as a person. Also, in case of cash transfers, the money reaches directly to you Aadhaar linked bank account. You do not have to pursue different people to get the funds, besides you can decide which bank account you want to take money in. But all benefits go to your latest Aadhaar linked bank account. You cannot decide that one will go to one bank account and another one to the other bank account.



FAQS ABOUT MAHADBT SCHOLARSHIP PORTAL

Q-5) What if a Resident gets rejected by the UIDAI and is not issued Aadhaar?

The reason for rejection along with steps to be taken post rejection will be communicated to the resident and the Registrar.

- a) Resident can find his Aadhaar number by using Aadhaar Service-Retrieve Lost UID/EID.
- b) Resident can call 1947 where our Contact Centre Agent will help the User in getting EID number. The resident can further use this EID to download e Aadhaar from Resident Portal - e Aadhaar.
- c) Resident can get Aadhaar number on registered mobile from Resident Portal - Get Aadhaar Number on Mobile

Q-6) After I get enrolled, how long will it take to get my Aadhaar letter? And how do I get my Aadhaar letter?

Aadhaar generation may take up to 90 days. Aadhaar letter is delivered by post. Once Aadhaar is generated, you also get a SMS on registered mobile (if mobile number provided during enrolment).

Q-7) Can we register/ change mobile number online?

For any online update request, including updating of mobile number, resident should already have an active number registered with UIDAI where person can receive OTP SMS and authenticate himself/herself. Otherwise you would need to visit nearest UIDAI permanent enrolment centre.

Q-8) Do I need Aadhaar to get my DBT?

Government Of Maharashtra encourages all citizens of Maharashtra to have Aadhaar number so as benefits can be directly transferred to Aadhaar seeded Bank account. DBT portal navigates citizens to visit nearest PEC center to enroll themselves for Aadhaar.



FAQS ABOUT MAHADBT SCHOLARSHIP PORTAL

Q-9) Have multiple accounts, where will I receive the money?

Please give your copy of Aadhaar letter with your bank account number written on it or copy of your bank passbook to the bank where you want to receive the funds. The bank may require you to fill a form as well. Updating your mobile number in bank is also advisable. This will send out SMS alerts when you get DBT in account or you transact on your account. Please note that the bank account which has been seeded last with the Aadhaar number will be the one to receive money through DBT.

Q-10) What is the process of Offshore Banking (Banking Correspondent), my village?

Banking Correspondent carry a hand hold device, which can allow you multiple type of banking transactions on your Aadhaar linked Bank account. Transactions possible are Balance, Enquiry, Cash Deposit, Cash Withdrawal, Paying Bills, Remitting funds to other Aadhaar holder. Banking Correspondent also helps in opening of Aadhaar linked bank account.

Q-11) Why are Government schemes asking for Aadhaar?

It helps schemes to clean out duplicates and fakes, to provide accurate data and enable implementation of direct benefit programmes. Use of Aadhaar reduces the costs of identifying persons and provides Increased transparency to the government in implementation of its schemes.

Q-12) Changed to what is the procedure to make corrections in Aadhaar details?

Based on which document needs name correction, such document should be corrected. In case the name correction is to be done in Aadhaar, then you can visit the nearest permanent enrolment center to update your name, age, address, mobile number and other demographic details (list available at www.uidai.gov.in) or you can also update the details online by using SSUP portal or by sending the updation/correction form by Post on Address available on website along with supporting documents. Based on the type of update relevant documentary proof will required to be furnished.



FAQS ABOUT MAHADBT SCHOLARSHIP PORTAL

Q-13) Will an AADHAAR enabled bank account be opened with every issue of an AADHAAR number?

AADHAAR enabled bank accounts will be opened for every resident, if he or she chooses to consent to the same. This consent will be requested from the resident at the time of enrolment itself. The accounts would be opened for everyone including children.

Q-14) What is the difference between Aadhaar linked bank account and normal bank account?

It is envisaged that disbursement of social security benefits like pensions, scholarships, MGNREGS wages etc. would be through Aadhaar enabled bank account. UIDAI is actively working with states/central ministries to designate Aadhaar enabled accounts for disbursal of all social security benefits. The individual would be able to access his/her AADHAAR enabled bank account through a low cost interoperable micro-ATM network which will have large geographical reach. Instant payments through biometric authentication and mobile payments will also be enabled in the future for such accounts.

Q-15) I have accounts with more than 1 bank and I have linked all accounts to Aadhaar. Which account can I use for making digital payments using Aadhaar Number?

You can use all accounts. While making Aadhaar Based payment, you will be given an option to choose the bank name from which you want to pay. Thus you have the choice of deciding bank, each time you make a payment.

Q-16) How is Aadhaar different from any other identity issued by the government?

Aadhaar is a lifelong unique 12 digit random number assigned to a resident which is verifiable online anywhere anytime using the Aadhaar authentication platform. Aadhaar authentication responds only with yes/no answer. The Aadhaar Scheme is primarily aimed at improving the delivery of social security benefits and subsidies, plugging leakages and wastes, eliminating fakes and duplicates and enhancing transparency and accountability.



FAQS ABOUT MAHADBT SCHOLARSHIP PORTAL

Q-17) How to check the eligibility for the scheme?

The basic objective of the Check eligibility is to fetch relevant schemes that are applicable to the Applicant on the basis of the input provided by the applicant for eligibility Check.

Q-18) What are the different file formats which can be accepted?

JPG and PNG Format.

Q-19) What is the Max File Size for uploading document?

The maximum file size a user can upload is 250 KB.

Q-20) What is GRN No. in application form?

GRN is the General Registration Number. Applicant to contact School to get their GRN details. Combination of GRN and UIDSE will Fetch the details of Applicant Name, DOB, Gender, School Name from Saral.

Q-21) Overview Of Merit Scholarships for Economically Backward Class Students

This Scholarship is being awarded to enable economically backward class students to continue their further education. (Boys student from Class XI and XIIth only)

Q-22) How to check the status of the application after submission?

Login to the MahaDBT Portal, under the Application Tracking menu, the applicant can see the status of their application by entering the valid Application ID.



FAQS ABOUT MAHADBT SCHOLARSHIP PORTAL

Q-23) Can the application form be edited after submission?

Yes, If the Institute sends back the application to student for modification in that case applicant can modify some specific fields.

Q-24) Can the application form be stored in draft mode?

Yes, the Applicant can able to store the application form in draft mode.

Q-25) How would I know that DBT funds have come to my account?

We recommend that you update your mobile number in bank. The Bank will send out SMS alerts when you get DBT in account or you transact on your account. Alternatively, you can also check your account balance using ATM, microATM/ Banking Correspondent, internet banking or calling the bank for details of your transactions.

Q-26) If your SSC & HSC board not shown in SSC & HSC Details Dropdown list?

1. Select the Other board from the SSC/HSC details section.
2. Fill all mandatory fields in SSC/HSC details section manually.(i.e. Board Name, Seat No., Name on SSC Certificate, the Total Marks, Marks Obtained).

Q-27) If Your College Name/Course Name Missing from College Name & Course Name field Dropdown?

Select the check box which is displayed at the bottom and add College Name & Course Name, University Name manually.

Q-28) For Aadhaar-Bank linking status?

Q-1) What are the features of Vidyasaarathi Portal?

Vidyasaarathi portal provides single window for students to access information and make application for educational scholarships. It has the following features:

1. Information about various educational scholarships.
2. Apply to multiple Educational Scholarships & Schemes.
3. Facility for Corporates to download Students Scholarship Applications & Review the same.
4. Facility for Educational Institutes/Corporates to register online.

Q-2) Objective of providing Educational Scholarship through Vidyasaarathi?

To provide financial assistance to meritorious students from low income families to meet a part of their day to day expenses while pursuing higher studies.

Q-3) How to register on Vidyasaarathi portal?

1. Login to our website : www.vidyasaarathi.co.in
2. Click on the "Sign Up" button at the extreme top most right hand corner
3. Fill the basic required fields
4. Click on the "Submit" button to create your account on vidyasaarathi
5. Please note, the activation link would be sent to your registered email id
6. Once email id is verified, click on the "login" button

Q-6) Where to contact for any query?

Q-7) What if I forget password of my Login ID?

You can click on "Forgot password" option provided on the Login page of Vidyasaarathi Portal and you will be asked to provide your registered e-mail address. Vidyasaarathi Portal will send a system generated password on your registered email address.

Q-8) Which fields in the Profile/application form are mandatory?

Fields provided with red asterisk (*) mark are mandatory fields.

Q-9) List of documents I need to be ready with before filling application.

Please **click on scholarship scheme name** for mandatory documents.

Q-10) Can I edit the information already saved and upto what time?

All the information can be edited till the closure of application form. After final submission, your application will be forwarded to the next level and application hereby cannot be edited

Q-11) Where can I see eligibility criteria for scholarship?

In "**Browse available Schemes**" click on scholarship scheme name for eligibility criteria.

Q-12) What will be the Maximum Scholarship Reward available?

The maximum amount of scholarship that can be rewarded, will be less than or equal to the educational course fees as stated in the admission certificate or fee receipt. Also the Scholarship amount is subject to differ from scheme to scheme, Institute to Institute and from course to course.

Q-13) What if in some cases scholarship scheme is not showing/displayed under "Search and Apply" Tab?

As per the input provided by the student, if student do not fit into the eligibility criteria, then scholarship cannot be provided.

Q-14) What is Scholarship Reimbursement?

Instances where the student has already paid the educational fees for the current academic year, in those cases the amount of scholarship will be disbursed to the **student bank account** against the paid fee receipt duly acknowledged by the educational institution.

Q-15) Which are the education scholarship schemes I can apply through Vidyasaarathi portal?

Before login you can view all the list of scholarship scheme on vidyasaarathi portal by clicking on "**Browse available scheme**"

However, for eligible scheme and matching to your profile. You have to login on vidyasaarathi portal fill the profile and submit then click on '**Search & Apply Schemes**' tab.

Q-16) How should I check the status of my application online?

You have to login on portal by entering your registered email id and password. Once login, you will be redirected to dashboard. Under the field header named '**Action**' you can check your applications current status.

Q-17) How the fund for scholarship is disbursed/transferred?

Scholarship of an applicant will be disbursed directly to the applicant's registered bank account or institute bank account.

Q-18) What is 'Application In-Progress' status of Scholarship application?

The entity will mark the scholarship application status to '**Application In-Progress**' when the application is under processing or not considered for further processing by the authority.

Q-19) What is 'Application Incomplete' status of scholarship application?

The authority will mark the scholarship application status to "**Application Incomplete**" when the authority needs further more details or clarity from student's to process the application to next level.

Q-20) What is 'Application Resubmitted' status of scholarship application?

When student changes or rectifies the details which were marked as incomplete and then submits the same then the form will be shown as "**Application Resubmitted**".

Q-21) What is 'Screening Completed' status of scholarship application?

The authority will mark the scholarship application status to "**Screening Completed**" when the online application form is correct and screened by authorized authority to next level.

Q-22) What is 'Document Verification Pending' status of scholarship application?

When status changed to "**Document Verification Pending**" Students required to go for physical verification with their original submitted documents. These students will be advised to visit the nearest facilitation centre. The details of the same will be communicated to the respective students via email or call.

Q-23) What is 'Document Verification Successful' status of scholarship application?

When Facilitation Centres (FC) verify the original documents of students with documents uploaded in the system then Facilitation centre will mark the application as "**Document Verification Successful**" i.e. student details are verified.

Q-24) What is 'Document Verification Unsuccessful' status of scholarship application?

When Facilitation Centres (FC) found document uploaded in the system is not genuine or not matched with the original documents then Facilitation centre will mark the application as "**Document Verification Unsuccessful**".

Q-25) What is 'Assigned to Approver' status of scholarship application?

The authority will mark the scholarship application status to "**Assigned to Approver**" when the application is forwarded to next level of entity committee for review.

Q-26) What is 'Verified by Approver' status of scholarship application?

The entity will mark the scholarship application status to "**Verified by Approver**" when the committee will approve scholarship amount to the candidate. This application will then be forwarded to the final level for their approval.

Q-27) What is 'Scholarship Awarded' status of scholarship application?

The entity will select the deserving student for scholarship and mark the application status as "**Scholarship Awarded**" for further process. It means student has been shortlisted for scholarship amount but processing of amount will take some time

Q-28) What is 'Payment File Generated' status of scholarship application?

Status "**Payment File Generated**" refer to scholarship amount/fund is under process by Trust bank which will take some time for process.

Q-29) What is 'Disbursed status' of scholarship application?

Status "**Disbursed**" refer that scholarship amount/fund is credited to student bank account or Institute bank account. If amount/fund not credited check with your bank or you can contact us on Vidyasaarathi@nsdl.co.in or call our customer care number 022-40904484.

Q-30) Why is my Scholarship application showing Rejected/Closed?

You may not be eligible as per the norms laid down by the selected entity or Institutes.

Document uploaded is not genuine or not available to verify.

Student delay in replying of entity query.

The selection of a candidate for scholarship is completely under the purview of the entity and it has the right to award scholarship to anyone it feels appropriate. Further, they have the right to reject any application without stating any reason for the same.
